II. Salvation (Romans 3:21 through 5:11)

A. The propitiation of God through the sacrifice of Christ (3:21-25)

- 1. The propitiation of God is the springboard for salvation**
- 2. The propitiation of God through the sacrifice of Christ fulfills all that the Old Covenant sacrifices only looked forward to.**
- 3. The propitiation of God through the sacrifice of Christ finally removes the penalty of sins which were only covered over (atoned) in the Old Covenant.**

B. The justification of man (3:26-5:11)
